## TIP OF THE MONTH




The best way to reach into model airplanes and install servo screws is with a magnetic screwdriver. You can also make your own simply by placing an inexpensive button magnet, like those used to hold a hatch closed, on the shaft of the screwdriver. This way, the screw will stay on the tip and you can guide it into the servo grommet and attachment hole. You can also use this technique to retrieve hardware that you may have dropped into the bowls of your plane. The magnets can also be used for retaining screws on your workbench or at the field, so they don't roll around and get lost.
